**Destination ImagiNation®** offers youth a framework to develop their teamwork, creativity, and problem-solving skills. DI motivates young people by encouraging them to look for the challenges in life and see them as opportunities for growth. During this course, team members will develop their higher order thinking skills by creatively solving problems over both long and short periods of time. DI Teams form with up to seven members, and choose one of several mind-bending challenges in the technical, fine arts, science, improvisational, structural, and service learning areas. Each team independently crafts a solution over the course of the school year, within a limited budget. *Every part of the solution is created by the youth team members using their own ideas and capabilities.* Adults act as facilitators, providing general skills training, improvisational critical thinking skills, logistical support, and snacks!

In addition to working on the long term goal of the team challenge, teams will also be given weekly instant challenges to help foster their team's ability to think quickly. **Cost: \$240 (includes one time \$20 material fee) from January 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2012-May 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2012  
(\$12 PER CLASS FOR CURRENT ENROLLED MEEP STUDENTS. Total 20 classes)**

### **NON-MEEP STUDENTS**

**Cost: \$280 (includes one time \$20 material fee) from January 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2012-May 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2012  
(\$14 PER CLASS FOR NON-MEEP STUDENTS. Total 20 classes)**

**Please note: Class will NOT be in session: 3/27/12 due to school closure.**

**Please note: Full payment is due December 8<sup>th</sup>, 2012**

Only checks, cash, and money orders are accepted.

Returned checks will be assessed a \$35.00 fee.

- **Refund policy:**

90% refund until January 6<sup>th</sup>, 2012

50% refund January 13<sup>th</sup>, 2012

No refunds will be given after January 13<sup>th</sup>, 2012

There must be a minimum of 10 students enrolled in the class at all times. If the minimum is not met, classes will be discontinued and you will be refunded the amount for the number of remaining classes. There is a maximum of 14 students.

If a child is absent, tuition will not be refunded for the missed class. If the teacher is absent, the class will be made up.

Children enrolled in Destination Imagination classes must be picked up once class is over at 3:00 p.m. There will be a late fee of \$5.00 per minute for pick ups after 3:00 p.m. There will be a late fee of \$10.00 per minute after 3:10 pm. If your child has not been picked up by 3:30 p.m., we are required by law to contact Child Protective Services (CPS).

**PLEASE NOTE: LATE FEES ARE IN EFFECT UNTIL THE STUDENT IS PICKED UP!**

All parents are required to sign their child out upon pickup.
