Flamenco comes from Andalusia, in the South of Spain. Flamenco originated with the arrival of Gitanos or Gypsy people from India, North Africa, Turkey and Eastern Europe and fusing their rhythms with Flamenco folk music.

Kids will learn “floreo” (hand movements); “palmas” (clapping); a little bit of “taconeo” (footwork), which is the percussion; and to sing “jaleos,” which are shouts to encourage and support each other when dancing.

I believe that dancing is not only a great outlet for energy and expression, but also a great exercise for coordination, concentration and memory. I have been studying flamenco for 4 and a half years already and I love it, so I’m hoping to share this art form with you and to have lots of fun in this class!

Sandra earned her Bachelor Degree in Journalism and Mass Communication from the University of Lima. **Cost: \$192 from January 6th, 2012-May 18th, 2012
(\$12 PER CLASS FOR CURRENT ENROLLED MEEP STUDENTS. Total 16 classes)**

NON-MEEP STUDENTS

**Cost: \$224 from January 6th, 2012-May 18th, 2012
(\$14 PER CLASS FOR NON-MEEP STUDENTS. Total 16 classes)**

Please note: Class will NOT be in session: 2/17/12, 3/16/12, 4/6/12 and 11/24 due to school closures.

Please note: Full payment is due December 8th, 2012

Only checks, cash, and money orders are accepted.
Returned checks will be assessed a \$35.00 fee.

- **Refund policy:**
 - 90% refund until January 11th, 2012
 - 50% refund January 18th, 2012
 - No refunds will be given after January 18th, 2012

There must be a minimum of 10 students enrolled in the class at all times. If the minimum is not met, classes will be discontinued and you will be refunded the amount for the number of remaining classes. There is a maximum of 14 students.

If a child is absent, tuition will not be refunded for the missed class. If the teacher is absent, the class will be made up.

Children enrolled in Flamenco classes must be picked up once class is over at 3:00 p.m. There will be a late fee of \$5.00 per minute for pick ups after 3:00 p.m. There will be a late fee of \$10.00 per minute after 3:10 pm. If your child has not been picked up by 3:30 p.m., we are required by law to contact Child Protective Services (CPS).

PLEASE NOTE: LATE FEES ARE IN EFFECT UNTIL THE STUDENT IS PICKED UP!

All parents are required to sign their child out upon pickup.
